# Notes About TELPAS

The Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS) is an assessment program for students in Texas public schools who are learning the English language.

This annual assessment of English learners (ELs) evaluates the progress that each EL makes in becoming proficient in the use of academic language in four domains:

Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing

ELs receive a proficiency rating based on how they perform in each domain:

- **Beginning** - reflective of students in the early stages of learning English.
- **Intermediate** - reflective of students who can routinely use English, but need support due to academic barriers caused by English.
- **Advanced** - reflective of students who can understand and use English in most situations, however they still need assistance with grammar and vocabulary.
- **Advanced High** - reflective of students who can use academic English in classroom activities with little or no assistance.

# TELPAS Administration & Scoring Updates

During the 2016-2017 school year, Reading was the only domain assessed online. Listen, Speaking, and Writing were scored by trained TELPAS raters, which allows for subjectivity.

During the 2017-2018 school year, Reading, Listening, and Speaking were all assessed online, leaving only Writing open to subjectivity by TELPAS raters.

Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, each domain will be weighted equally for scoring (25% each), as opposed to the domain weights in prior school years (Listening 10%, Speaking 10%, Writing 30%, Reading 50%).

Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, qualifying ELs who take the STAAR-Alt2 assessment will also take the TELPAS-Alternate.
